- Place doormats at entrances, non-slip rugs in high-wear areas and protective pads under furniture legs.
- Do not use abrasive brushes, steel wool, soap detergents or ammonia based cleaners.
- Take care when moving appliances and furniture by placing them on a sturdy mat to slide into position.

- The board has a 4 side UNICLIC® profile for a tight board-to-board fit and consistent finish.
- The clear coating highlights the natural colour and timber features.
- No mess and fumes from sanding and finishing.
- Pentarch Engineered Flooring can be walked on within hours of installation.

Installation Requirements

Pentarch Engineered Herringbone Parquetry™ must be glued down over a level subfloor such as a concrete slab, particleboard or plywood sheeting or over old timber floors. It is recommended that parquetry flooring in installed by a professional as it requires specific methodology and equipment.
